



Medicaid Formulary Coverage

The Texas Drug Code Index includes program-specific formularies for Medicaid, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), the Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) Services Program, the Healthy Texas Women (HTW) Program, and Kidney Health Care (KHC) Program. HHSC requires managed care organizations to adhere to the Medicaid and CHIP formularies.

These formularies include:

- Legend drugs.
- Over-the-counter drugs.

Other products available as a pharmacy benefit, include:

- Home health supply products, including aerosol chambers, diabetic lancets and test strips, hypertonic salines, insulin needles and syringes, oral electrolytes, spring-powered lancets, and talking monitors.
- Influenza vaccines.
- Long-acting injectables.
- Long-acting reversible contraception products.
- Mosquito repellents.
- Vitamins and minerals.

Use the online Formulary Search to identify drug coverage, fee-for-service pricing, and drugs subject to one or both types of prior authorization—clinical and non-preferred.
